One of the main goals of the Columbia University, Teachers College MA Program in Japan is the professional self-development of those who work in various situations in the Japanese educational context.

Many teachers have requested shorter training programs at the Tokyo campus, so in response Teachers College, Japan Campus is pleased to offer its 7th **Intensive Program for Integrated English Teaching Skills**. The program aims to provide a short specialized period of study for English teachers who work in Japanese schools. It is organized to assist teachers in exploring ways to develop integrated teaching skills, while also improving their English language ability and communicative skills. The participants will examine current English teaching issues in the Japanese context, and explore practical teaching ideas to motivate their students. Participants will finish the program with a range of teaching ideas they can experiment with immediately in their classrooms.

Participation Requirements

The program is open to anyone currently teaching English in Japan. There is no specific English language ability requirement, but all the lectures and instructions will be given in English, so participants are recommended to have English language ability sufficient to handle the course content. Bilingual teaching assistants will be there to facilitate discussions and answer questions during class. All participants who satisfactorily fulfill the participation requirements will receive a certificate of attendance from Teachers College, Columbia University.

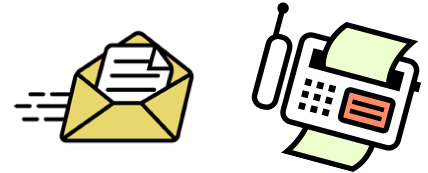
*授業は英語で行われますが、バイリンガルのアシスタントが教室内に常時待機しております。

She has taught at the Monterey Institute of International Studies, the New School Online University, Hunter College, and at Teachers College in New York. She teaches in the online MA in TESOL Program at Anaheim University with Kathleen M. Bailey, Rod Ellis, David Nunan, and Ruth Wajnryb. She was a featured speaker at JALT 2005, and is currently the incoming chair of the TESOL Standing Committee on Diversity. She is the co-author of two ESL textbooks, *Changes: Readings for Writers* and *Inspired to Write*, and her articles have appeared in *The Journal of Basic Writing*, *The Language Teacher*, and *PacCALL*, among others. Over the last ten years, she has taught courses for Teachers College, Columbia University Japan Campus.
